





### Safety information and precautions

- Keep the LIFE LINE<sup>™</sup> kit and medical oxygen cylinder away from naked flames and sources of heat. Medical oxygen is a non-flammable gas, but it does strongly support combustion
- Ensure medical oxygen cylinders are stored in a safe and secure area where they cannot fall over and cause injury
- Ensure the LIFE LINE<sup>™</sup> kit and medical oxygen cylinder are stored in a well-ventilated area
- Never use excessive force when opening or closing the cylinder using the black handwheel
- Never paint the cylinders. All labels and markings must remain clearly visible
- Do not use oil or grease (or any oil-based products which includes hand creams) on or in the vicinity of the medical oxygen cylinder. Combining medical oxygen and oil/grease can cause spontaneous combustion
